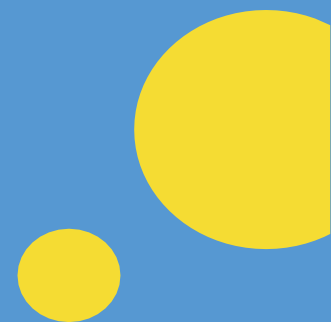


# Stonehouse



## About Stonehouse

NNL's Stonehouse office is based at Stonehouse Park. The office is located close to the headquarters of EDF energy, one of our biggest customers. Much of the work done from this office is in support of EDF Energy.

The staff based at NNL Stonehouse are primarily from the Reactor Operations, specialising in the materials, chemistry and corrosion associated with operating reactors. In addition, the Fuel Cycle Solutions is represented at NNL Stonehouse by a reactor safety and licensing specialist.

NNL does not presently maintain any experimental capabilities at the Stonehouse office, though members of staff are actively involved in research at the University of Bristol's Interface Analysis Centre and the School of Chemistry's autoclave facilities. NNL Stonehouse also have a dedicated laboratory at the University of Bristol.

Approximately 15 people are based at Stonehouse.

## Working at Stonehouse

### Office Opening Hours

Opening hours at Stonehouse are 08:00 – 17:00 Monday to Friday. A key holder needs to be present so you can gain access to the office.

Stonehouse has a group calendar in Outlook called STONEHOUSE\_GROUP\_CAL used to manage who is opening the NNL Office and for residents to add when they plan to attend the office.

Access to the calendar will be granted for residents and regular attendees.

### Accessibility

Should you require any reasonable adjustments or additional facilities whilst working at Stonehouse, speak to your manager or your HR Business Partner. The Reasonable Adjustments Passport will be completed so arrangements can be made accordingly.

### Hybrid Working

NNL has adopted a hybrid approach to work, which enables you to combine working from home with working on site. Currently, there are no formal arrangements in place for Hybrid Working at Stonehouse, on arrival your Line Manager will allocate you a desk.

### Welfare Facilities

Male, female/disabled toilets can be found in the upstairs and downstairs foyers. A lift is also available at this location.

Kitchen facilities are available in the office suite, where tea, coffee and milk are provided. The kitchen is equipped with a fridge, toaster and microwave.

A sandwich van visits site every day just before lunch time and a coffee shop can be found within walking distance of the office.

### Car Parking

Parking is provided at the front of the building and, in general, vehicles should be parked in the spaces allocated to NNL.
